Message From The Pro Shop

January started off a little wet but I can't believe what kind of turn it's taken for the better. The weather has been amazing and that should be continuing into February so we are sure to see more and more golfers enjoying the courses. Many of you have renewed your membership for this year which is great to see and if anyone has yet to do so, let us know if you have any questions or need help renewing your membership.

We continue to lose range balls and baskets from the range which is constantly causing our range balls to deplete and we've had some struggles keeping up with the machine so I need to kindly ask everyone to not remove balls, baskets or the rubber tees from the range. We also continue to struggle with keeping private golf carts away from the greens on a regular basis and this is a constant problem. We do this to keep the closely mown areas in the best shape possible especially in the winter months when the grass is thinner than normal. Please help us out and keep your carts 30 yards from the greens and 15 yards if you are handicapped. I continue to see carts very frequently parked close to the green and since we can't have someone out on the course monitoring it at all times, please help us out and respect the cart rules. If we continue to see carts get too close to the greens, the next step will be to rope off every green so no carts can get close to the green and I would hate to have to resort to that so we need your help as much as possible.
