## Message From The Pro Shop

I can honestly say that unfortunately winter is officially here and with that comes the rain. Because the courses drain well, the conditions haven't been too bad with the exception of a couple heavy rain days. Make sure and take advantage of the beautiful days when we get them over the next few months.

A reminder that when the courses are cart path only due to the rain, the Summit range will also be closed and only the front of the range will be open that day. I believe I mentioned this in my last message as well but from now until Spring, the driving range will be mats only and please refrain from hitting off the grass.

Membership renewals are well underway and I've noticed that there are quite a few members that haven't renewed for next year yet. Make sure you come in and renew your membership for next year to make sure that you don't have a lapse in your membership. The value of the memberships next year is going up because of the increases coming in rates and range ball prices. Here are some details about next years rates to see the value you get with signing up for any of the 3 different memberships.

Range ball prices are currently \$6 for a small, \$9 for a medium and \$12 for a large. As of January 1<sup>st</sup>, the prices are increasing slightly to \$7 for a small, \$10 for a medium and \$15 for a large. We are also going to make sure the range balls themselves are consistently better as well as not running out of range balls as has happened in the past.

Current public rates for this year during the week are \$67 in the morning, \$52 from 11:00 – 2:00 and \$37 after 2:00. Weekend rates are \$77 in the morning, \$62 from 11:00 – 2:00 and \$42 after 2:00. The rates as of January 1<sup>st</sup> are going up by \$1 in the mornings and for the mid day rates. The afternoon rates will be increasing to \$40 during the week and \$45 on the weekend. But the best part for the member rates is that they are not increasing at all so they will be the same as they are now which increases your savings per round. And other great news is that the rate breaks will stay at 11:00 and 2:00 all year long, no longer will the rate change go back to 12:00 and 3:00 during daylight savings time. The last price increase will be for the 9 hole rate which will go from \$30 weekday and \$35 weekend to \$35 weekday and \$40 weekend.

We are excited for 2025 and we hope all of you are as well and continue to play golf at Lincoln Hills. Happy Holidays to everyone.
